	<p><b>Canning Crescent</b> The new canning crescent site is being developed in collaboration with the Clarendon Recovery College and Safe Haven Crisis Café. Crisis Prevention House: The aim is for this space to provide short stay supportive care to prevent the need for longer inpatient admissions. Clarendon Recovery College – A space to learn and develop knowledge and skills that is empowering and based around building on an individuals strengths and personal goals. Crisis Café – a space to attend between 5 -9pm and some day time hours at the weekend if an individual needs extra support, a place to come together to engage in conversation and activity to prevent further crisis.
